Surely God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart! But as for me, my feet came close to stumbling, my steps had almost slipped... For <u>I was envious</u> of the arrogant as I saw the prosperity of the wicked. Psalm 73:1-3

1. Faith Never Grows in an Atmosphere of Comparison.

For there are <u>no pains in their death</u>, And their <u>body is fat</u>. They are <u>not in trouble</u> as other men, <u>nor are they plaqued</u> like mankind. Therefore pride is their necklace; The garment of violence covers them. Their eye bulges from fatness; The imaginations of their heart run riot. They mock and wickedly speak of oppression; They speak from on high. They have set their mouth against the heavens, And their tongue parades through the earth. Therefore his people return to this place, And waters of abundance are drunk by them. They say, "How does God know? And is there knowledge with the Most High?" Behold, <u>these are the wicked</u>; And <u>always at ease</u>, they have <u>increased in wealth</u>. Psalm 73:5-12

2. Our Faith Cannot be Contingent on Blessing.
