How are we supposed to live?

1. We remind ourselves that true life is found in dying to ourselves and following Jesus.

"If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him.

2. Even with our "troubled souls" we choose to glorify God.

"Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, 'Father, save Me from this hour'?_But for this purpose I came to this hour. **"Father, glorify Your name."** John 12:27-28a

- 3. John 13: We make it a priority to love and serve one another.
- 4. John 14: We don't let our hearts be troubled because we believe in God. We believe in Jesus. We believe in heaven.
- 5. John 15: We abide in the Word and let the Word abide in us.

- 6. John 16: We surrender completely to the control of the Holy Spirit so that we can be doing the works of Jesus and receiving comfort from Him.
- 7. We fix our eyes on Jesus.
