koinonia - to share, to participate in a common cause, to fellowship.

#### 2) A DISCIPLE OF JESUS BELIEVES AND IS CONNECTED

And all who believed were together and had all things in common. Acts 2:44

- Christians enjoy a <u>personal</u> relationship with Jesus.
- Disciples enjoy a <u>shared</u> relationship with Jesus.

## 3) A DISCIPLE OF JESUS BREAKS BREAD TOGETHER
