Habakkuk - prophet to Judah - (the Southern Kingdom of Israel) He prophesied from about 621-609 BC.

Three Invasions of Judah by the Chaldeans (AKA Babylonians):

- 1. 605 BC when Daniel and many of the nobles were captured
- 2. 597 BC Ezekiel was taken
- 3. 586 BC Jerusalem and the temple were destroyed

"Behold, as for the proud one, His soul is not right within him; But <u>the</u>
righteous will live by his faith.

"The righteous will live by his faith"

For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed--a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: <u>"The righteous will live by faith</u>."

Romans 1:17 NIV
