WHAT YOU <u>BELIEVE</u> DETERMINES HOW YOU <u>BEHAVE</u>.

It affects us relationally, morally, financially and spiritually.

THE FATHER OF LIES

(The devil) was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the <u>truth</u>, for there is <u>no</u> <u>truth in him</u>. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the <u>father of</u> <u>lies</u>. John 8:44b

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who <u>suppress the truth by their wickedness</u>...Although they claimed to be wise, <u>they became fools</u>... They exchanged the truth of God <u>for a lie</u>... Romans 1:18, 22, 25

THREE OF SATAN'S GREATEST WEAPONS:

- 1) **RELATIVISM**
- 2) **SUBJECTIVISM**
- 3) EXPRESSIVE INDIVIDUALISM
- Relativism—assumption that there is no such thing as absolute truth.
- Subjectivism—I, the subject, have the right to determine what is right and wrong without submitting my judgment to any <u>authority</u> outside myself.
- Expressive Individualism the view that the whole point of a person's existence is to be authentic; that, for individuals to be authentic, they must align their lives with their deepest desires; and that, for societies to be authentic, they must applaud individuals for aligning life with their deepest desires
- 01. Blaming: If we can find a scapegoat to blame the trauma on
- 02. Magical thinking: If we can believe a fantasy
- 03. Prediction: If we can predict the future, then we can feel in control
