## I. Expect persecution.

**18** "If the world hates you, <u>know</u> that <u>it has hated me before it hated you</u>. **19** If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, <u>but</u> I chose you out of the world, <u>therefore</u> the world hates you. John 15:18-19

**20** <u>Remember</u> the word that I said to you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' <u>If they persecuted</u> <u>me, they will also persecute you</u>. If they kept my word, they will also keep yours. John 15:20

**21** But <u>all these things they will do to you on account of my name</u>, <u>because</u> they do not know him who <u>sent me</u>. **22** If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have been guilty of sin, <u>but</u> <u>now they</u> <u>have no excuse for their sin</u>. John 15:21-22

**<u>23</u>** Whoever hates me hates my Father also. **24** If I had not done among them the works that no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin, **<u>but now they have seen</u>** and hated both me and my Father. **25** But the word that is written in their Law must be fulfilled: <u>'They hated me without a cause.'</u> John 15:23-25

**2** <u>Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds</u>, **3** for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. James 1:2-3

**3** We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing. **4** Therefore we ourselves boast about you in the churches of God for your steadfastness and faith in all your persecutions and in the afflictions that you are enduring. **5** This is evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering—**6** since indeed God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, **7** and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels. 2 Thessalonians 1:3-7
