## HOW TO BE MISERABLE

### 2) COMPARE WHAT YOU HAVE TO PEOPLE WHO HAVE MORE.

### 3) PURSUE TEMPORARY POSSESSIONS OVER ETERNAL TREASURES.

***"Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."*** Luke 12:15

### 4) RESENT GOD FOR WHERE YOU ARE IN LIFE.

### 5) DEVELOP AN ATTITUDE OF ENTITLEMENT.
